PK-12 Incentives

~“Bring a Buddy” Incentive: Any family who brings a new family to CC who is accepted for the 24-25 school year will receive an adult athletic pass for the 24-25 school year.

~January 5 to January 31 is early registration for returning families if you enroll K-12 student(s)

~February 1 to March 28 early registration. Families will receive \$100 off the \$250 for one K-12 registration fee.

~March 28 to June 1 \$50 off the \$250 for one K-12 registration fee

~ All preschool families who re-enroll/enroll by Feb. 29, 2024, will receive \$25 off of the \$100 registration fee.
