PK-12 Incentives

~"Bring a Buddy" Incentive: Any family who brings a new family to CC who is accepted for the 24-25 school year will receive an adult athletic pass for the 24-25 school year.

~March 28 to June 1 \$50 off the \$250 for one K-12 registration fee
