Kindergarten

These items will be collected and passed out when needed

- 1 ream of computer paper(boys)
- 24 #2 yellow pencils (Ticonderoga)
- 6 boxes of 24-pack crayons
- 2 small pink erasers
- 10 unscented glue sticks
- 6 Expo dry-erase markers (black only)
- 1 box Ziploc sandwich bags with write-on strip (girls)
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 container of baby wipes(girls)
- 2 containers of cleaning wipes, Lysol or Clorox

These items will need to be labeled with your child's name please.

- 1 plastic pencil box
- 1 washcloth to use on dry-erase board
- 1 pair of Fiskars scissors
- Bookbag (no wheels, and make sure folders will fit inside)
- 2 plastic folders with pockets (1 green and 1 blue)

First Grade

These items will be collected and passed out when needed

- 24 wooden pencils
- 10 unscented glue sticks
- 8 Expo dry-erase markers, fine tip (**black only**)
- 2-3 pink erasers

- 1 roll of paper towels
- 4 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 package of baby wipes
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer

These items will need to be labeled with your child's name please.

- 1 **plastic** supply box (no cloth zipper pouches)
- 1 pair of Fiskars scissors
- 4 boxes of 24-pack of crayons
- A small cloth or a whiteboard eraser
- 3 folders (**1 green, 1 yellow, 1 blue**), put name on each
- Book bag, put name on it
- Headphones in a baggie with name labeled (make sure they are comfortable)

Second Grade

- 4 dozen #2 Ticonderoga pencils SHARPENED - **label 1 dozen with name, others will be put aside for use later in the year**
- 4 unscented glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 boxes of 24-pack of crayons
- 2 boxes of colored pencils
- 2 boxes of markers
- 8 Expo dry-erase markers (fine tip/skinny, black)
- A pack of large pink erasers
- Pack of pencil erasers (that go on the end of pencils)
- 2 different color highlighters
- SOFT pencil case
- 2 plastic two-pocket folders
 - One for daily home transport (any color)
 - a red one with the student's name on it
- 1 Mead composition notebook, wide-ruled
- 2x2 Post-it notes
- book bag
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 3 boxes of tissues (Square)
- 3 containers of Lysol/Clorox wipes
- 1 box of gallon-size storage bags
- **Boys-** 1 box of quart bags / **Girls-** 1 box of sandwich-size bags.
- **REQUIRED** headphones or earbuds with a cord. Remove headphones from packaging and put them in a gallon ziplock bag (please label bag with student's name)

- Baby wipes (x2)
- Dry erase pocket sleeve (You can find them sold individually at Dollar Store)
- Hand sanitizer

Third Grade

- 4 dozen #2 Ticonderoga pencils -
- 2 boxes of 24-count crayons
- 1-2 boxes of colored pencils
- 8 dry-erase markers
- 4 highlighters
- 2 pink erasers
- scissors
- 3 unscented glue sticks
- soft pencil case for glue stick, scissors, eraser, dry erase marker, highlighter, and pencils
- Soft bag for crayons and colored pencils (pencil case)
- bookbag
- 1 packages of white 3x5 index cards
- REQUIRED headphones or earbuds with a cord. (No earbuds or blue tooth) Remove headphones from packaging and put them in a gallon ziplock bag (please label with the student's name)
- 3 two-pocket folders
 - One for daily home transport (any color)
 - a blue one for Language Arts class
 - a green one for Math and Social Studies class
- 1 white 1/2 inch binder with dividers (not bigger).
- 1 Pop-it will be used for spelling, the alphabet can already be on it, or will be put on.
- Baby wipes
- Lysol wipes
- 1 box of tissues (we may need more later in the year)
- 1 box of gallon size zip lock bags (needed from BOYS Only)
- 1 box of sandwich size zip lock bags (needed from GIRLS only)

- **NO markers, permanent markers, or pens will be used in third grade.**

***Pencils, colored pencils, crayons, highlighters, and dry-erase markers get used up or lost often. You may want to keep some at home to resupply as needed.

- **Science** (*Label with subject & student name*)
 - 1 green pocket folder
 - 1 green subject spiral notebook
- **Math** (*label with subject & student name*)
 - 1 blue pocket folder
 - 1 blue subject spiral notebook
- **Social Studies** (*label with subject & student name*)
 - 1 yellow or orange folder
 - 1 yellow or orange spiral notebook
- **English** (*label with subject and student name*)
 - 1 red pocket folder
 - 1 red subject spiral notebook
- **Reading** (*label with subject and name*)
 - 1 purple pocket folder
 - 1 purple subject spiral notebook

*****NO permanent markers, Post-its, white out, zipper binders, or hanging locker decorations will be used in 4th grade. These will be sent home if brought to school.**
